



## **In Memory of Bruce Poinsette**

It is with a heavy heart that we share the news of Bruce Poinsette's death on May 8, 2024. Bruce was an active, cherished member of our ASSP community since 1987. He was a dear friend, a mentor, and educator who shared his time and talent with anyone who didn't meet code (smile) and anyone willing to learn about safety at work, at home, on the roads or anywhere for that matter. His dedication and contributions to ASSP have left significant reflection on our organization and lives. Bruce was a novelty in being a one time, two-term Past President, serving 1995-1996 and 1996-1997. Coupling his experience with legislature and safety, he was uniquely qualified to serve as our Chapter historian and Government Relations Chair.

Bruce's memorial service was held on Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup> and was attended by fellow ASSP members and beyond. Our Chapter sent flowers in gratitude for Bruce's commitment and service to our chapter. The request from the family is to plant a tree in memory of Bruce. Figuratively, Bruce planted trees his entire life, many of which the shade he will never sit.

# **Congratulations to Jimmy Gibbons!**


